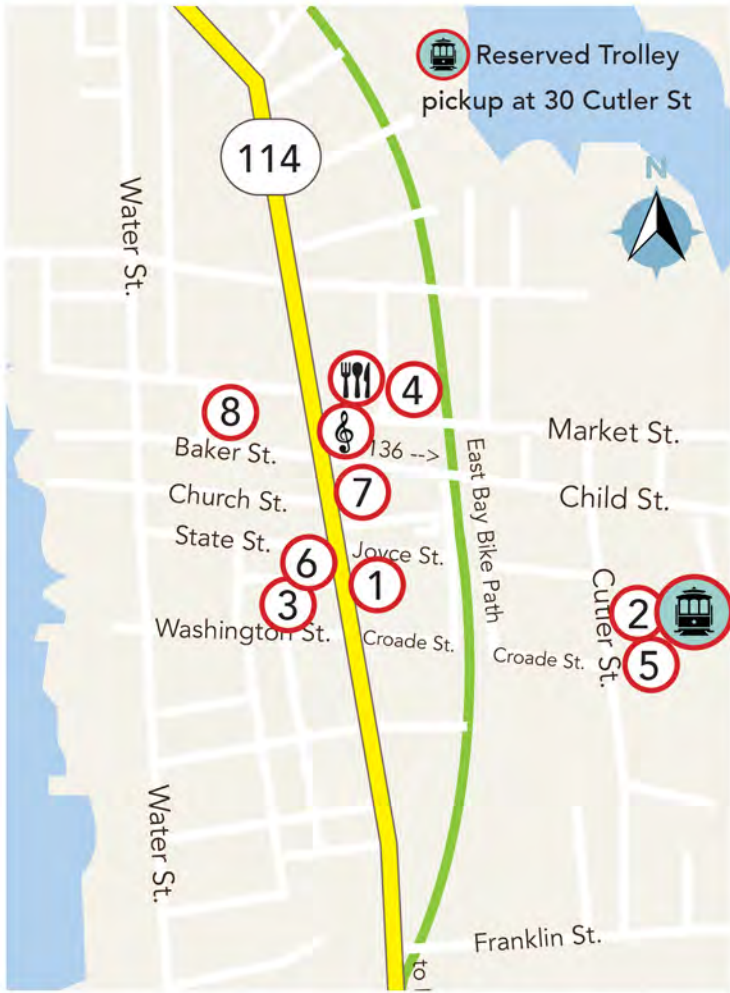

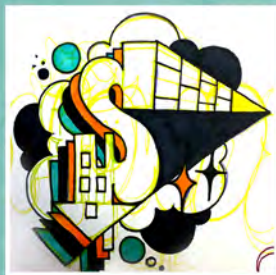

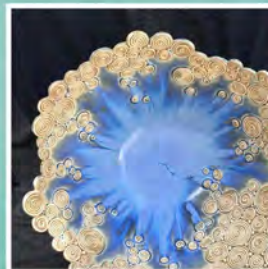

• **7Suns Printmaking** (Studio #204) will be featuring student artist **Emily Gray**.

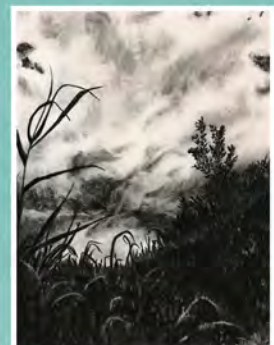
• **Cheryl Perry & Ian Buchbinder** (Studio #213A)

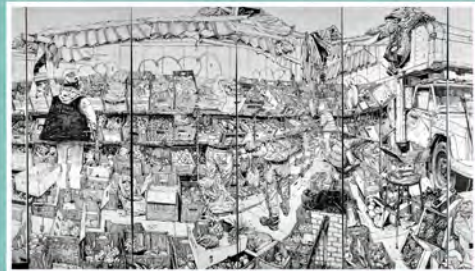
## IMAGO GALLERY • 36 MARKET ST 4

Called BLACKGREYWHITE, Harrington's work includes photography, painting and mixed media pieces. Ehrens' work consists of still life photographs of plant ephemera she placed in woodland streams, creating imagery that is lyrical & contemplative. 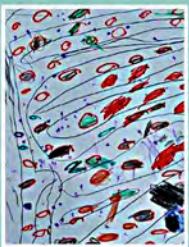

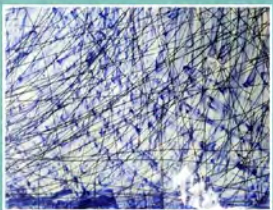

## WASHINGTON LODGE MASONIC TEMPLE • 39 BAKER ST 8

The building is on the National Register of Historic Places and an integral part of the Warren Waterfront Historical District. Warren's craftsmen constructed the Federal-style building with oak timbers from ships sunk across Newport Harbor in 1770's

The fresco murals on the 2nd floor were selected from the works of "Book of the Dead" & "Papyrus of Ani". **Max Muller**, a member of the Lodge and a graduate of RISD, hand painted the murals in 1915.



Join us for a guided tour of Lodge and Murals at 5:40 pm.

From the heart of the Ocean State, **Hollow Turtle** has been playing powerful folk/bluegrass music together since their high school days. Since 2014, Nick Preite, their ever-skilful mandolin player, Joe and James Cappelletti, thrumming standing bass and natural finesse with a banjo respectively, and Alfie Purcell, guitar wizard, have been pleasing audiences throughout the area.
