#### FEATURED ARTISTS

"Preserve and Protect" is a series of mixed-media art by Ann Boyd. The acrylic based artworks portray a variety of colorful, textured animals whose conservation status is vulnerable or endangered. Mixed media techniques enable depiction of these animals with whimsy and wonder.

Temple Fawcett's work in felt has grown out of a love of fabric. Her current focus is on 3-dimentional figures in the form of women and birds, using a variety of materials and techniques. The recent "Whirly Birds" are many-legged (or footed) creatures, which come from the variety of twigs found on woods explorations.
