



Viola is a junior at The Greene School in West Greenwich. "I see things as if they were photographs. Interesting people and places add extra layers to life and pictures which create depth and joy."






Alex Godin's artwork is very bright, abstract, and geometric. He is a craftsman making handmade fabric wreaths with a variety of colors, textiles, and style.







Self Guided Walking Tour: Painting Pokanoket History

1. InkFish Bookstore Event, 5:30-6:30p.m.

A representative of the Pokanoket Tribe and the Sowams Heritage Area Coordinator will be on hand for an informal discussion of Ruth Major's painting of the Massasoit Ousamequin's village of Sowams and to answer questions.

2. Massasoit painting at George Hail Library

View a contemporary painting by artist Ruth

Major of the Massasoit Ousamequin, who met the Pilgrims in 1621, and who was reburied at Burr's Hill Park.

3. Massasoit's Spring

A monument to the Massasoit Ousamequin, Chief of the Pokanoket tribe in the 17th century until 1661, sits at the end of Baker Street in Warren, the site of one of the reputed aboriginal villages.

4. Burr's Hill Pokanoket Royal Burial Ground

Burr's Hill was an ancient Pokanoket royal burial ground containing dozens of grave sites. A monument to the Massasoit Ousamequin sits over a crypt containing over 500 artifacts.

5. Electric Box Painting

Electric Utility Box painting of Massasoit Ousamequin by artist The Lady J is on view at Main Street and Campbell.
