Open studio tours and casting demos starting at 5:30.







Maxwell House is on the corner of Water Street and Church Street





## WASHINGTON LODGE MASONIC TEMPLE

39 Baker Street, Warren



The building is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is an integral part of the Warren Waterfront Historic District. Warren's craftsmen, constructed the Federal-style building with oak timbers from ships sunk in Newport Harbor in the 1770's.

The fresco murals located on the second-floor were selected from the works of "Book of the Dead" and "Papyrus of Ani". Max Muller, a member of the Lodge and a graduate of the Rhode Island School of Design at that time, was the artist who hand painted the murals in 1915.

**Washington Lodge Masonic Temple** will be open on Art Night, June 29th, from 5:30 - 7:30 pm.






'Art in the Garden' will feature Ed McAloon's sculpture and furnishings created from recycled materials.

## Poetry reading at 6:15 by Pat Armstrong.






