
New to the neighborhood and showcasing local art, **Studio 246** is a working studio in a vibrant area!




DISH will be hosting a pop-up with jewelry artist **LeeAnn Herreid**.


On August 29th, Alexa McHugh will perform between 57 and 63 Water St (near The Greenery) from 5:30-7:30.
